All About Speechki for Self-Published Authors

Speechki was created to help publishers turn their books into audiobooks, but it can be used by self-published authors. Here is what self-published authors need to know.

- Speechki provides the recording with more than 360 synthetic voices in 77 languages and dialects, including dozens of US and UK accented English voices. Speechki does not have human narration available.
- The basic cost is \$500 or \$1000 per book (depending on which voice you choose) or \$120 for each hour of audio production. Pricing includes human proof-listening and corrections.
- Speechki does not distribute audiobooks It simply produces them from your text (PDF, Word, or ePub). Audiobooks are distributed by the same companies that do print and ebook production. Check with your distributor about audiobook distribution.
- Audiobooks with synthetic narration can be distributed through Google Play, Apple Books, Barnes & Noble, Spotify, and more. As of March 2022, Audible (and Amazon) will not allow audiobooks with synthetic narration sold through their platforms. Please check these facts when you'd like to proceed with Al-narration.
